

APPROVED PLANT MATERIAL LIST

The following list of plants is composed of selected native and adaptive plant material suitable for the plant habitat found in Plum Creek. This approved plant list is made up of recommended plants for installation on residential properties. This is not an all-exclusive plant list, but rather a list of appropriate plant materials, which for the most part, are readily available in the local nursery trade.

As regional and xeriscape gardening techniques become more mainstream, additional native plant species will become available in the marketplace as demand is increased. Therefore, this list of approved plants will be amended from time to time.
